2014-2015 was another great year for A Stepping Stone Foundation. The board, our staff and I gave our very best in order to serve our children, their families and our community. By the end of the service year, 46 families were better prepared to help their children succeed in school. Thirty-six children were ready to enter kindergarten; 12 in Miami, Arizona and 34 in Phoenix. Ten additional children were ready to return to preschool as a four-year-old.

A Stepping Stone Foundation's scholarship committee awarded twenty-nine Billie Gannaway Memorial Scholarships, which included the second round of five Ivey Stepping Higher Scholarships in celebration of Harriett Ivey's service to the Nina Mason Pulliam Charitable Trust. We welcomed four new board members and continued to be the recipients of two large program grants for our Alhambra and Miami Unified School District projects from the Bob and Renee Parsons Foundation and the Kemper and Ethel Marley Foundation respectively.

Moving forward, our hope is two-fold. First, build a strategic plan which includes key staff and key board members acquiring the knowledge and skill set to grow our capacity to serve more children and families. Ultimately, we would like to be in any community where there are 15 or more families in need of our services. Second, create sound planned and emergency succession planning for our senior staff. If I, or another key staff member, should wish to leave or become suddenly unavailable due to unforeseen circumstances, we will have a plan in place to continue to move forward.

As always, one of the most important parts of our continued success lies in your hands. Thank you for your contributions in their many forms; your financial and in-kind donations (see the list on pages 5-7), the time you donate to our cause and your willingness to tell others about what we do and why we do it. Thank you for your past support and we hope we can continue to count on you now and in the future.

Last year was a year of growth for all. Our preschoolers participated daily in activities which fostered their developmental growth and prepared those aged four for kindergarten. They had the opportunity to go on field trips to the Desert Botanical Garden's Pumpkin Patch, Phoenix Children's Museum, Tolmachoff Farms, the Butterfly Museum and the Phoenix Zoo. Five babies were added during the course of the year! In addition to their ESL or GED classes, our parents participated in parenting workshops which included: brain development, Raising a Reader, Kith and Kin and a writing workshop by author, Stella Pope Duarte. We ended our year with a Parent Celebration which recognized their achievements.

Today, our classrooms are full of energy and excitement. Parents have started their adult education classes and program obligations with much enthusiasm. They continually tell me how thankful they are for the opportunity to learn and grow with their children. I get to spend time in each of our classes weekly and invite you to visit to see in person what an impact ASSF has on the families who participate. You can contact our office to schedule a tour. In Miami, preschool classes started in August and they have already taken a field trip to the Gila County Fair. Parents have started their GED and ESL classes and parenting workshops. It is wonderful to see all aspects of our program implemented in this partnership with the Miami Unified School District.


